Conditions of Entry

- 1. The exhibition** is open to all people in the gay, lesbian, bisexual, queer, transgender & intersex communities, including family & friends. They also must have been born in Tasmania or be a current resident.
- 2. The exhibition** aims to promote a variety of media, including paintings, prints, photographs, drawings, ceramics, textile hangings & sculpture.
- 3. All work** must be the original work of the artist, not have been exhibited in any other exhibition, & completed in the last 12 months.
- 4. Entry fee** is \$20 for each artist (\$10 GLCC Inc member or concession). The fee must accompany the entry form.
- 5. Entries close 21 August, 2009.**
- 6. Each artist** may enter up to three works only, due to limited space. If large numbers of entries are received, not all works may be exhibited.
- 7. Artists should** write a ten-line brief about their work/s for the catalogue and email the brief/s and, if possible, digital photos of their work/s to: artfullyqueer@taspride.com
- 8. All works** must be delivered to either Arts Alive Launceston, or the designated collection point in Hobart at 39 Burnett St, Nth Hobart (WIO & GLC offices) no later than COB Friday, 4th September. Delivery to one of these points is the responsibility of the artist.
- 9. All works** must be collected from the Gay and Lesbian Community Centre, 39 Burnett Street, North Hobart on Monday 12 October 2008 from 9am – 5pm. Pick-up is the responsibility of the artist.
- 10. All work** is to remain in the Arts Alive art space from 8 - 19 September and Moonah Arts Centre from 25 Sept - 8 October 2009.
- 11. All pictures** must be ready to hang. They must have screw eyes and wire attached or D hooks - no staples or string please! No wet work will be accepted.
- 12. Exhibitors must** allow their work to be reproduced to publicise the exhibition.
- 13. Very large** works may not be accepted due to size of venues.
- 14. All entries** are exhibited at the owner's own risk. The Gay & Lesbian Community Centre (GLCC Inc), Moonah Arts Centre, Glenorchy City Council and Arts Alive will not accept liability for loss, damage or theft. Please note that both exhibition spaces have reliable security systems and that the works will be stored in a secure facility in between venues.
- 15. Works may** be made available for sale. No commission will be taken. Artists will be put in contact with interested buyers. The Gay & Lesbian Community Centre (GLCC Inc), Moonah Arts Centre, Glenorchy City Council and Arts Alive are not responsible for exchange of money for purchase of works.

16. Art work not accompanied by a completed Delivery Form will not be accepted for exhibition.

17. Exhibitors are encouraged to help sit the exhibition at the Moonah Arts Centre weekdays from 12.30pm – 5pm & Saturdays from 10am – 2pm.
