These are some of the questions we hope to answer and ask in **into the wild & OUT**, the 6th Annual Artfully Queer exhibition of queer Tasmanian art presented by the Gay and Lesbian Community Centre (GLCC).

The exhibition opens at the Moonah Arts Centre at 6pm on Friday 24 September and runs until Thursday 7 October 2010.

Opening night will feature liquid refreshments, gourmet finger food, short speeches and the announcements of the 2010 prize winners. Though details are still being finalised, we're hoping to award a similar range of prizes as in 2009, with a new prize to be sponsored by Working It Out for the artwork that best celebrates diversity.

The following afternoon, Saturday 25 September, Artfully Queer will facilitate a discussion by a panel of local GLBTIQ artists talking about their work and answering questions. We hope to host an evening of queer performance on the following weekend.

Entries are open right now for into the wild & OUT. Entry is open to all members of the Tasmanian GLBTIQ community, their families and friends. Entry is free for GLCC members. The concession entry fee is \$15 and the non-concession entry fee is \$25, the same price as joining GLCC. The completed entry form, which is inside this brochure, must be received by Friday 10 September 2010 and artworks must be delivered to the Moonah Arts Centre by 5pm on Wednesday 22 September 2010.

Conditions of entry

The exhibition is open to all people in the gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, intersex, queer (GLBTIQ) communities, including their family and friends, who were born or are currently residing in Tasmania.

The exhibition aims to promote a variety of media. All artistic media are welcomed.

Entry is free for members of GLCC. For non-members, entry is \$15 concession or \$25 non-concession, the same price as GLCC membership. To become a member of GLCC, please go to the TasPride website www.taspride.com.

Entry forms must be received by Friday 10 September 2010.

Each artist may enter a maximum of three works only. If large numbers of entries are received, not all works may be exhibited due to limited space. Very large works may not be accepted due to limited space.

All work must be the original work of the artist, must not have been exhibited in any other exhibition and must have been completed in the last twelve months.

All artists should write a ten-line brief about themselves and each work for the exhibition catalogue. This should be emailed, along with digital photos of each work, to artfullyqueer@taspride.com by Friday 17 September 2010.

All works must be delivered to the Moonah Arts Centre between 12.30pm and 5pm on Monday 20, Tuesday 21 or Wednesday 22 September 2010. Delivery is the responsibility of the artist. All works must be accompanied by a completed Delivery Form. Delivery forms will be sent out to artists after entry.

Artists must allow their work to be reproduced by GLCC to promote this and future exhibitions.

All works are to remain in the Moonah Arts Centre from delivery until 5pm Thursday 7 October 2010. All works must be collected from the Moonah Arts Centre from 5pm – 8.30pm Thursday 7 October 2010 or between 9am -12.30pm Friday 8 October 2010. Collection is the responsibility of the artist, unless the work has been sold and paid for and prior arrangements have been made between the artist, the organisers and the buyer for its collection.

Works may be made available for sale. A commission of 10% will be charged by GLCC for works sold for over \$100. GLCC will manage the sale of works and will not release the work to the buyer until the artist has been paid the full amount minus the commission if applicable. The artist selling the work must provide their bank account details for direct deposit.

All entries are exhibited at the owner's own risk. GLCC, Moonah Arts Centre and Glenorchy City Council will not accept and liability for loss, damage or theft. Please note that the exhibition space has a reliable security system and the exhibition will be supervised when open to the public.

Exhibitors are encouraged to help sit the exhibition.

The exhibition may travel to other venues later in 2010. Details are still to be finalised.

Prizes may be offered in a variety of categories, awarded by an expert panel of judges. Artists can choose to be excluded from judging for prizes, otherwise entry will be assumed. All works are automatically available for the People's Choice Prize.
